LOW TRAFFIC NEIGHBOURHOODS (LTN) ARE COMING TO HIGHBURY

## GET INFORMED

Under an Experimental Traffic Order (“ETO”) Islington Council is about to implement **Low Traffic Neighbourhood (“LTN”) Schemes**, with controls (including bollards and CAMERAS) going live on 11th January.

The ETO is a temporary order, lasting up to 18 months, which may become permanent unless we object. Islington Council must consult with residents before making these LTN schemes permanent and must consider complaints and comments received **by 30th April 2021**.

## OUR SOLUTION

EASE THE LTN DISPLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC ONTO OUR MAIN ROADS AND REDUCE ADVERSE LTN IMPACT THROUGH:

- ANPR to allow Highbury residents to drive within Highbury without being fined.
- ANPR exemption from fines also for delivery vehicles, emergency services, business permit holders, taxis, carers for disabled residents etc.
